REPORTS AND COMMUNICATIONS

- **Financial report:** Nothing to report.
- **Cemetery report:** The maintenance crew will weed eat the cemetery for the remainder of the year. Flowers left on the ground are adding man hours for the weed eating process. The ceremony for Memorial Day needs a better sound system; the school will let the VFW use their equipment. This information will be passed to the officers at the VFW.
- **Sewer report:** The pump for the North lift station that is at C&C pump for rebuilding will require an additional 4 weeks. The parts are on back order.
- **Park report:** The fencing has been repaired but it is residential fencing and will continue to need repairs. A new net is needed at the tennis court but will be readdressed this spring.
- **Recycle report:** Nothing to report.
- **Water report:** The lake has turned over due to the colder water temperatures on the surface verses warmer water temperatures on the bottom. Carbon is the only chemical to counter act the taste. It will take several days to clear this up.
- **Street report:** Maintenance crew still patching streets. They will begin to trim branches over roadways.
