- Moved by Long, second by Harvey to approve minutes for September 19, 2016 regular meeting. All Ayes.
- Moved by Long, second by Knope, to approve payment of invoices for October 3, 2016. Hobbs Nay, Dyson, Long, Harvey, Knope and Wine Ayes. Motion carried.

**REPORTS AND COMMUNICATIONS**

- **Financial report:** Nothing to report
- **Cemetery report:** Hobbs will meet with the young man that trimmed the grass and show him what is expected.
- **Sewer report:** Nothing to report.
- **Park report:** The committee listed the following items that needed to be addressed at the park:
  1. spray weeds on walking track
  2. pull weeds on playground
  3. benches at playground need boards replaced and painted.
  4. barrier is needed to keep chips from playground off the tennis court.
  5. more picnic tables are needed.Clerk will get prices of tables for next meeting.

- Mayor Marlow appointed Scott Wine from the water committee and Tabitha Knope from the finance committee to assist the clerk in revising procedures for the collection of delinquent water bills.
